Applications must be received by midnight EST on June 18, 2010.

Late or incomplete applications will not be processed.

Eligibility

Please enter only items you have made or designed. *By submitting your application and photos, you guarantee that the work presented is your original creation.* We reserve the right to dismiss any exhibitor if they have misrepresented themselves or their merchandise, or for any reason we deem appropriate.

We are limiting entries by category to ensure a variety of goods at Indie Craft Parade. In some cases, your work could be accepted by the jury, but your category filled. In this case, your name will be added to the waiting list, and you will be notified in the event that a space opens up within your category.

Jurying

Work will be judged based on how well it aligns with the vision of Indie Craft Parade, as well as its originality, quality, uniqueness, and innovation. The Jury may accept or reject some or all of the work represented by the photos that accompany an application. The following panel of professional artists will review all submissions: Kent Ambler, Kevin Isgett, Annie Koelle, Caroline George Lott, and Teresa Roche.

Fees

Payment of all fees will be handled through Paypal (you can pay via credit card or with your Paypal account). A link to our Paypal account can be found on the Apply page at www.indiecraftparade.com.

Application Fee: A non-refundable \$10 application fee is due with this form.

Exhibition Fee: The exhibition fee is not collected until applicants are chosen. Once participants have been selected, we will email instructions for paying this fee.

Other: If you don't operate a full-time business, please be sure to obtain a special retail license (\$20) from the City of Greenville for selling at craft shows. You can access the form on the Participant page of our website.

Booths

Full-size (8 ft. table), half-size (4 ft. table) booths, and a limited number of corner booths are available. Because we offer half-size booths, shared spaces are not permitted. Each exhibitor must apply and their work be juried separately. Please indicate your booth preference on the application, but be aware that corner booths will be allocated at the discretion of Indie Craft Parade.

Policies

Indie Craft Parade is a family-friendly event. Participants will be asked to remove any goods not in keeping with this atmosphere.

Each individual is fully responsible for their booth, display and merchandise. Indie Craft Parade can not be held liable for any loss, damage or personal injuries that may occur at the event.

If upon judging, your books are denied but your mugs are accepted, you may exhibit only the items in the approved category – in this case, the mugs.
