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International Photography Competition

The Silver Eye Center for Photography is pleased to announce *Fellowship 2010*, our international photography competition. Our distinguished juror is Deborah Klochko, Executive Director of the Museum of Photographic Arts in San Diego, California.

As we enter our 11th Fellowship year, we've expanded our eligibility requirements and the number of major awards.

The competition is now open to all international photographers, not just Silver Eye members. Secondly, we are now awarding two Fellowships. The first carries a \$3,500 award and is open to all eligible photographers. The second award, new in 2010, is open only to Pennsylvania residents and carries a \$1,500 award. Both winning artists' work will be exhibited at Silver Eye in shows opening in late November 2010.

Deborah Klochko became Executive Director of the Museum of Photographic Arts in 2007. Prior to joining MoPA, Deborah served as a private consultant; as the Executive Editor of *see*, an award-winning journal of visual culture; and as founder of *Speaking of Light: Oral Histories of American Photographers*. Formerly the Director of The Friends of Photography in San Francisco, she has also worked at the George Eastman House, International Museum of Photography and Film, in Rochester, New York, and the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C. Deborah holds an M.A.T. in Museum Education from The George Washington University in Washington, D.C. and an M.F.A. in Photographic Studies from the Visual Studies Workshop in Rochester, New York.

Eligibility

- The \$3,500 award is open to all international photographers.
- The \$1,500 award is open only to Pennsylvania residents, who may apply in both categories.
- Silver Eye staff and their relatives, Board members, current interns, past Fellowship winners and those 18 and under are not eligible to apply.

Entry Fees

- The entry fee is waived for all Silver Eye members at the \$35 (college students) and \$70 membership levels and above (memberships must be current through December 31, 2010).
- The flat entry fee for non-Silver Eye members is \$55 (USD).

How to Enter

- Submissions are limited to ten images from a cohesive, exhibition-ready body of work and must have been completed within the past three years. Submitted images may not have been previously exhibited at the Silver Eye Center for Photography (onsite or online).
- Submissions accepted via CD only (not DVD) with CD and CD case labeled with your name and contact information.
 - Must be readable on a MAC.
 - No more than 10 JPGs of images from a body of work, series or project.
 - JPG resolution 72 ppi and no larger than 1280 pixels at the longest dimension.
 - Assign a file name for each JPG, titled in this order: first initial/last name, checklist number and title (e.g.: SJones1_Landscape.jpg).
 - Include a PDF or Word document (on CD) that identifies name of artist, contact information, checklist, and a short bio and artist/project statement (not to exceed one page).
 - The checklist must include title of work and/or series, date of work and/or series, medium, print size, and size and method of presentation of work (including final framed dimensions, if applicable).
 - Incorrectly formatted or corrupt files and incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
 - Silver Eye reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify and remove any entry that does not comply with the above requirements and guidelines.
 - Materials will not be returned.

Exhibition Notes

- Winning artists are responsible for packing (in a reusable container) and paying for one-way shipping and transit. Silver Eye will pay for return shipping and transit insurance and for insurance while on premises.
- Work must be received no later than November 10, 2010.
- Work must be professionally framed (Plexiglas only) and ready to hang.
- Artists must provide at their own expense any special installation hardware or equipment.
- Silver Eye retains 40% of the price for work sold during the exhibition.
- Artists agree to participate in related publicity and to the use of their name and likeness for the purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity without additional compensation.
- Artists must be able to supply a high-resolution image(s) suitable for print media and for personal, non-commercial electronic viewing. Copyright and credit lines will accompany all image files distributed to media.
- Silver Eye reserves the right to disqualify and remove any work that does not comply with above requirements or whose quality is not reflected in the submission materials.

Deadline for Entries

Entries must be postmarked or delivered on or before:
Friday, August 27, 2010, 6:00 p.m.

Entries must be complete upon submission.
